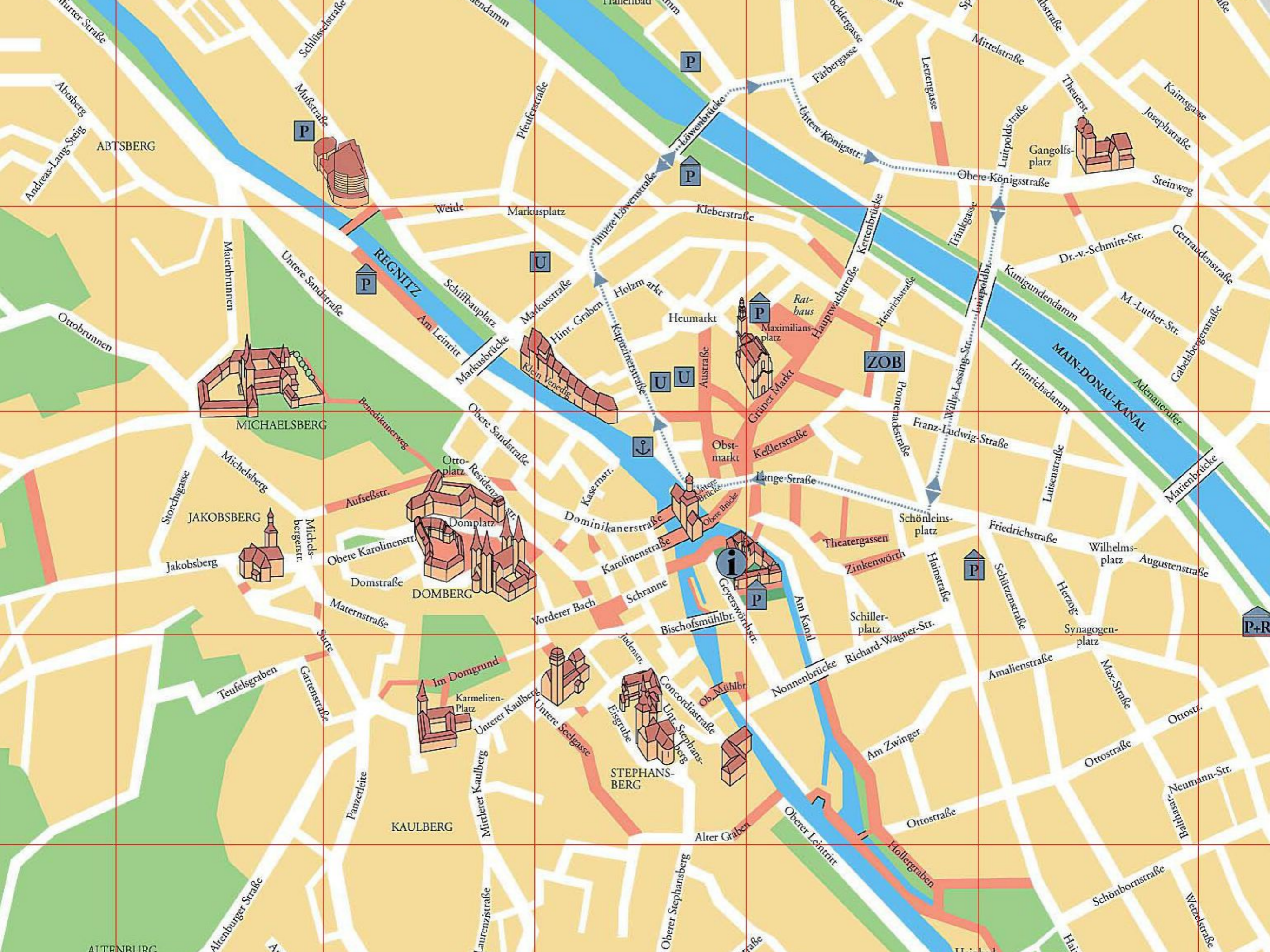

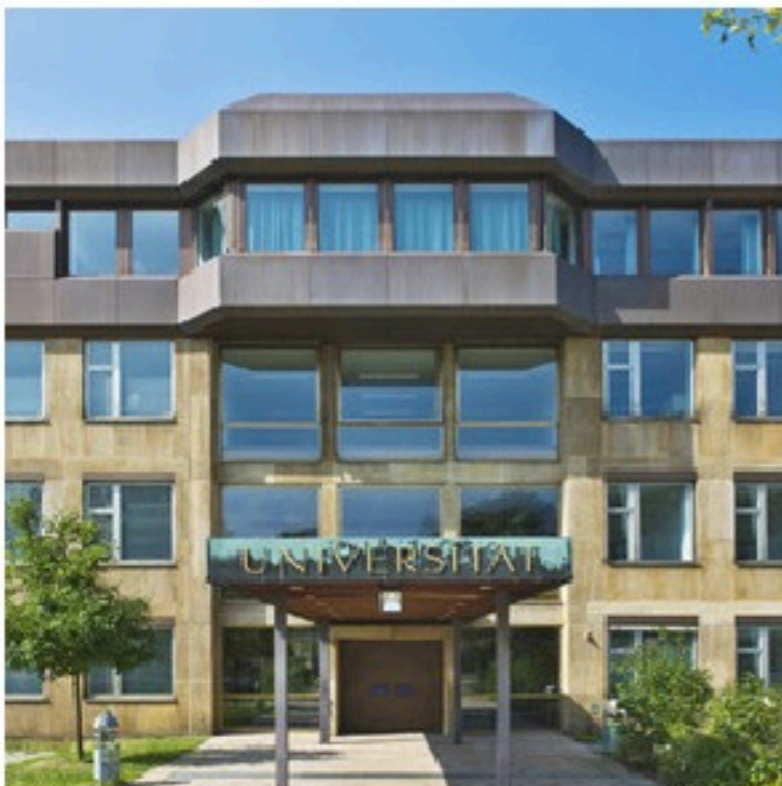

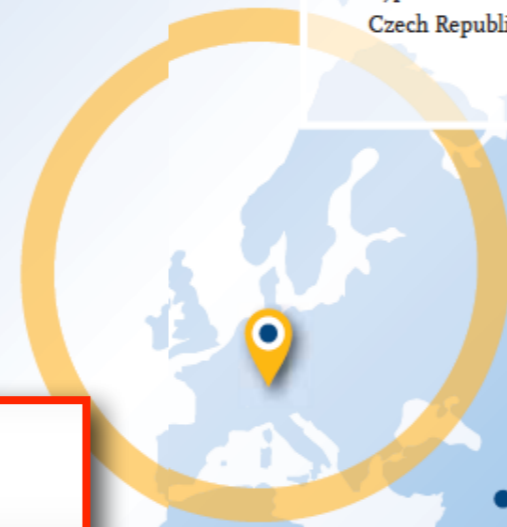

This master's degree programme is geared towards graduates of English and/or American studies and those graduates who are interested in pursuing international careers in academia and other occupational areas. The programme allows you to define your own individual area of specialisation, learn an additional language and select from a wide range of course modules. Moreover, the programme's small course sizes allow for individual support and instruction of the highest quality. The integrated mobility semester may be spent at any of the consortium's partner institutions.

This master's degree programme presents a broad range of analytical skills pertaining to the field of philological and cultural analysis, as approached from an explicitly historical perspective. You will learn to apply interdisciplinary analytic methods to the field of German philology and to prepare your findings for presentation to a broader public. An integrated professional internship provides you with the opportunity to gain practical training and experience. This binational degree programme requires that students spend one semester abroad.

The University of Bamberg's many study abroad programmes and English-language seminars allow you to pursue your studies from an international perspective that reflects your own interests. This is possible in many degree programmes, but the following examples are particularly noteworthy:



Bachelor's Degree in International Business Studies & Management (IBWL)

In keeping with its global orientation, this degree programme offers a large portion of its course content in English. You can also improve your proficiency in additional languages like Spanish, French or Russian in business-specific language courses. One year of foreign studies and two business-specific foreign languages are required for the degree, and the programme curriculum combines multiple disciplines whose contents have been carefully chosen for their relevance to future managerial positions in internationally active corporations and organisations.

Master's Degree in General Linguistics

As the bulk of this degree programme is offered in English, it is an attractive opportunity for foreign students to study linguistics in Bamberg. Small groups and close contact with instructors, as well as the possibility of selecting an individual area of focus and the option to pursue studies or internships abroad all contribute to the programme's appeal. What's more, studies in any number of different linguistic fields are possible: the Slavic, Romance and English languages are just as much of an option as the languages of the Middle East and the Caucasus.

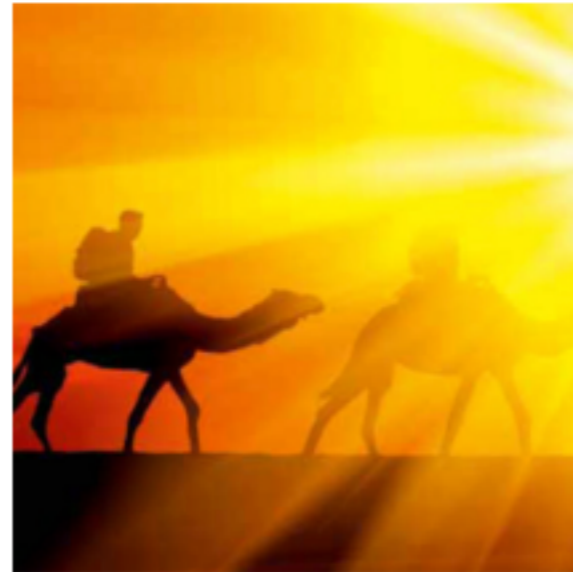

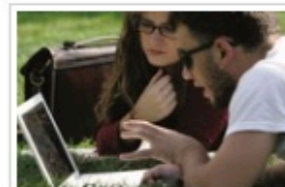

Admission Criteria

Among the requirements for being admitted to the programme are:

- a BA in English and American Studies or a similar area with a result of 2,5 („good“/B) or better
- very high level of language proficiency, certified by a minimum score in one of the standard language tests (TOEFL, IELTS)
- a convincing letter of motivation written in English

Application

Students send their application forms to the academic co-ordinator of the programme at the home university of their choice. The deadline for applications is 15 May; the study programme regularly starts in the winter term.

The programme co-ordinators of the partner universities then select the students for the programme and assign the universities for the mobility terms. Students will be informed whether their application has been successful before end of June.

The English-taught European Joint Master's Degree in English and American Studies offers a unique opportunity for students to study a language and a culture of global importance while experiencing the international character of academic life at first hand. The programme offers specialized academic training in English and American Studies focusing on the three core areas of literature, linguistics and cultural studies. Study Programme

Bayerische Hochschulen präsentieren sich in Sankt Petersburg

BAYERISCHES HOCHSCHULZENTRUM FÜR MITTEL-, OST- UND SÜDOSTEUROPA

Vom 18. bis 26. April fand in Sankt Petersburg die jährliche Deutsche Woche statt, die diesmal das Bundesland Bayern in einem vielfältigen Programm zu Kultur, Wirtschaft, Bildung und Gesellschaft in den Vordergrund stellte.

Im Themenbereich Bildung koordinierte BAYHOST die Beiträge bayerischer Hochschulen. Am 22. April präsentierten sich 5 Universitäten und 5 Hochschulen für angewandte Wissenschaften auf einer vom DAAD-Informationszentrum Sankt Petersburg organisierten Messe etwa 500 interessierten und gut vorbereiteten Schülerinnen und Schülern, Studierenden und deren Eltern, um sie an Informationsständen und in Kurzvorträgen über Studienmöglichkeiten in Bayern (Bachelor, Master, PhD und Austauschprogramme) zu informieren. Etwa ein Viertel der Besucherinnen und Besucher verfügte über Deutsch-Kenntnisse, die anderen suchten englischsprachige Angebote. Das Interesse an einem Studium in Deutschland war erstaunlich groß, besonders an naturwissenschaftlich-technischen Fächern wie z.B. Informatik. Eine Hürde stellt die Tatsache dar, dass

russische Schulabsolventinnen und -absolventen erst ein Jahr lang ein Studienkolleg besuchen oder in Russland studieren müssen, um sich für einen Bachelor in Deutschland einschreiben zu dürfen.

Die Vertreterinnen und Vertreter bayerischer Hochschulen nahmen am 23. April außerdem an einem ebenfalls vom DAAD organisierten Seminar zu Studiengängen mit Doppelabschluss teil. Prof. Dr. Sebastian Kempgen, ehemaliger Vizepräsident der Otto-Friedrich-Universität Bamberg, und Florian Chitic von der Wirtschaftswissenschaftlichen Fakultät der Katholischen Universität Eichstätt-Ingolstadt wirkten als Referenten an einem Runden Tisch mit und brachten ihre Erfahrungen mit Double-Degree-Programmen ein. Weiterhin wurden bereits bestehende Doppelabschlussprogramme mit Petersburger Hochschulen vorgestellt und darüber gesprochen, wie solche Programme erfolgreich aufgesetzt und beworben werden
